

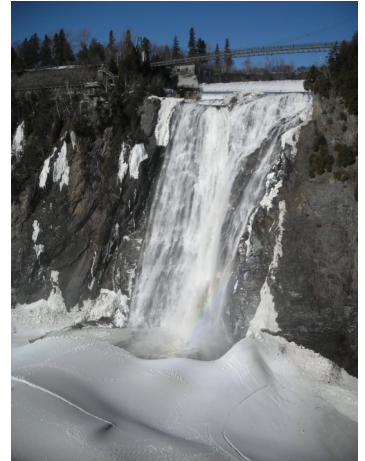


Squeaky Wheel Adventures is a travel camp for Maine kids in foster care, other out-of-home care and children that have been adopted.

## Winter Trip / 4-day Quebec in Winter

This international trip is a great adventure with amazing sights, the excitement of a foreign country and even some adrenaline. We will travel in our new bus to the Province of Quebec Canada through north-western Maine. Once we arrive in Quebec City we will spend sometime exploring the Old City and getting a feel for the French Culture there. After dinner we will use the pool at Laval University.

Our second day will be spent at the “largest winter playground in America”. Village Vacances Valcartier is tubing and *SNOW RAFTING* like you have never seen before. Similar to a downhill ski mountain, you will be pulled up the mountain by one of 17 lifts and come sliding down on your choice of several types of...vehicles, including a 12 person river raft! This place is a ton of fun and we are thrilled to be including it on this trip. This is an all day event with tubing into the evening.



On the third day we will explore the region further including stops at the icy falls of Chutes de Montmerency, the Plains of Abraham, and Quebec

City before the day's finale of a QJMHL hockey game featuring Quebec City's own Remparts. These games are exciting and a true Canadian tradition.

For our final day we will have a relaxed morning before beginning our journey back to Maine.

Please contact your caseworker ASAP and let them know that you are interested and then contact us to reserve a spot. There may also be post-adoption funding available.
