## **Winter Trip - December 2011** **Slides & Trails**

Be one of the first to travel in Squeaky Wheel Adventures awesome new 12 bunk bus! We will start our trip by traveling to North Conway, NH where we will dive into a tropical adventure at **Kahuna Laguna**, northern New England's first **indoor water park**. Who says you can't go to a water park in the winter? From water slides to wave pools we will spend the afternoon getting wet and having fun. Afterwards we will make our way to a nearby parking location (our home for the night in the bus) where we will cook dinner and play games before going to bed.



After breakfast we will travel to Holderness, NH where we will **snowshoe West Rattlesnake Mountain**. The trip up West Rattlesnake by way of the Old Bridle Path is one of the best snowshoes trails in New Hampshire's Lakes Region. At 0.9 mile one way, this short and easy journey will reward you with its beautiful views. Once you're up at the 1,260-foot summit, the views south and west of Big Squam Lake and the surrounding mountains are nothing short of spectacular. When we are finished we will continue on to Manchester, NH where we will spend our second night. Before going to bed we will enjoy a **night swim at the Manchester YMCA pool**.



On day three we will spend a couple of hours in the morning "giving back" a little bit by offering our help at the **New Horizons Food Pantry**. Christmas week is notoriously busy for Food Pantries and they are very excited to have our help. To complete our trip we will visit **Lucky 7 Stable** in Londonderry, NH for a **winter horseback trail ride**.

There may also be post adoption funds available. There are multiple pick-up locations for this trip.
